Proposals will be received at the City Clerk's Office, 710 E. Mullan Avenue, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, 83814, by 4:00 pm on August 7, 2019, for professional engineering consultant services for the Huetter Transmission Main project for the Water Department.

The purpose of the project will include identification of potential routes for a new transmission main, design of the water main, acquisition of any necessary right of way, and design of a wastewater transmission main for the Hayden Area Regional Sewer Board.
