COEUR D'ALENE TENNIS ASSOCIATION

MENS SPRING BASKETBALL

We will offer a Men's spring basketball league. League play begins Monday March 8. Team entry fee is \$380.00. Entry deadline is **Friday February 19**.

Recreational League – Mon & Wed. Competitive League – Tue & Thurs.
Teams choose game night. Teams play a 7 game schedule.

ADULT COED DODGEBALL

We will offer our 1st ever Coed dodgeball league in March. Team registration is **February 1 – March 5**. Team entry fee is \$80. which includes an end of the season tournament. A mandatory managers meeting will be held at 6:00 pm on Wednesday March 10 at Cd'A City Hall. All league participants must be at least 15 years old.

YOUTH VOLLEYBALL CAMP

Registration is **Feb 8 – 19** for grades 1-8. This camp is held at Woodland M.S. and run by CHS varsity volleyball coach Carly Curtis. Camp begins in March. Cost is \$30.

SPRING YOUTH SOCCER

We coordinate a youth soccer program for boys and girls in grades K-7.
K and 1st grades play micro soccer 3 on 3. 2nd – 7th play is 7 on 7.

You must be currently enrolled in a K program to be eligible for the Kindergarten league.

Registration will be held at our office from **Monday March 1 – Wednesday March 10**. Games will begin in April.

ADULT SOFTBALL

We will begin taking team registration for the 2010 summer season beginning February 1. Teams must pay the full sponsor fee with a roster before a league position is reserved. As a courtesy to other teams we cannot take partial payment, hold checks, or hold spots.

We will take a maximum of 46 teams per night. Team entry fees are listed below.

YOUTH & ADULT TENNIS CLASSES

CITY BEACH & INDEPENDENCE POINT

The Coeur d'Alene city beach will open Wednesday, June 9. City lifeguards will staff the beach from 11:00 am – 6:00 pm, weather permitting. Lifeguards are available to answer questions, respond to emergencies, and patrol designated swim areas.

However, we strongly recommend that you provide responsible adult supervision for children under your watch as you visit the beach. We also encourage you to provide your child with a life jacket if they have limited or no swim skills.

Our lifeguards are American Red Cross Lifeguard and United States Lifesaving Association training certified.

KIDS CRAFTS PROGRAM

We will be offering a crafts program for kids 3 – 5 and 6 – 9. This crafts class will be held each day Monday thru Friday the week of July 12 – 16. Classes will be held at the Jewett House. Age divisions will be strictly followed. Only 6 kids per class, so registration is limited. Kids must wear old clothes to paint in.

SUMMER SWIM LESSONS

We offer two sessions of swim lessons during the summer. Classes are held at City Beach. Children must be 6 years old to sign up for classes.

The first session will be held July 12 – July 23. The second session will be held July 26 – August 6. Registration for both sessions will be held **July 1 - 9**. Cost is \$25 for city residents and \$30 for non-residents.

FALL YOUTH SOCCER

We coordinate a youth soccer program for boys and girls in grades K-7. K and 1st grades play micro soccer 3 on 3. 2nd – 7th play is 7 v 7.

Registration will be held at our office from **Monday August 2 – Wednesday August 11 from 8:00-5:00**. Games will begin after Labor Day.

FLAG FOOTBALL

We will offer fall flag football for all 2nd & 3rd graders. Registration will be held from **August 2 – 31**.

The City of Coeur d'Alene does not offer tackle football. Cd'A Jr. Tackle, which is a private organization, does offer tackle football for grades 3 – 8. Registration information and contact phone numbers can be accessed on their website at **cdajrtackle.org**.

PUNT, PASS, AND KICK

We will host a local Punt, Pass, and Kick competition on **Friday, September 10** at McEuen Field. Registration will begin at 4:00pm. Competition will begin at 4:30pm.

Boys and girls ages 8 – 15 may compete. Age divisions are: 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15. Age is determined as of Dec. 31, 2010. 1st place finishers can advance to Sectional competition in Spokane. No football cleats or turf shoes are allowed. There is no fee.

COED FALL SOFTBALL

The Recreation Department in conjunction with Cd'A Softball Association will offer a fall coed league for a limited number of teams.

Team entry fee is \$460. Team entry deadline is **August 13**. League play begins Labor Day week. League play is offered Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs. Teams choose game nights.

YOUTH BASKETBALL

We will offer youth basketball for all 3rd – 8th graders. The season will begin in November and conclude just before Christmas.

All 3rd – 8th grade boys and girls may register at our office **October 1 – 8**. Children will be placed on teams by our staff and according to grade level and area. Games will be played on weeknights and Saturdays. Cost is \$26 for residents and \$31 for non-residents.

BOYS & GIRLS BASKETBALL CAMPS

We will hold our 2nd annual Veterans Day boys basketball clinic for K-8th grade. The camp will be held at Woodland M.S. on Thursday November 11 from 9-11:30 am. 9TH/10TH GRADE BOYS BASKETBALL

We offer a 9th/10th grade boys basketball league in 2010. The season will begin in December and run through January.

Any 9th or 10th grade boy may register at our office from **November 1 – 19**. Boys are placed on teams by our staff. 9th and 10th grades will be combined as a team. Games are weeknights and Saturdays. Cost is \$26 for residents and \$31 for non-residents.

MENS BASKETBALL

The Coeur d'Alene Recreation Department in conjunction with the Cd'A Mens Basketball Association will offer a Mens basketball league during the winter months.

Team entry fee is \$545. Team entry deadline is **October 18**. League play is offered in C & D divisions with an 11 game schedule beginning Sunday November 14.

YOUTH WRESTLING CAMP

We will again co-sponsor a youth wrestling camp with the North Idaho College wrestling team. The program is for children in K - 6th grade.

Registration will occur **December 1 – 31 from 8:00 – 5:00pm**. Cost is \$30.00. All participants receive a free t-shirt and 5 sessions of some of the best wrestling instruction in Idaho. The session ends with a post-season tournament. Enrollment is limited.

11TH GRADE BOYS BASKETBALL

We will offer an 11th grade boys basketball league in 2011. Registration will be held December 6 – January 7. The season will begin in January and run through February. Registration will take place **January 3 – 12** at the recreation office from 8 – 5 pm. League play will start in mid February. Games are played Mon–Thurs and Saturdays. We do use 8 foot baskets for practices and games. Cost is \$26 for residents and \$31 for non-residents.

YEAR ROUND PROGRAMS

DANCE CLASSES

One of our most popular programs is swim lessons for boys and girls ages 3 and above. Classes are held at the McGrane Center located in the Kootenai Medical Center complex.
