CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

PLEASE SUBMIT WITH APPLICATION: A FLOOR PLAN INDICATING ALL ROOMS IDENTIFIED BY USE OF EACH ROOM. CLEARLY IDENTIFY ALL WINDOWS BEING REPLACED, SIZE AND STYLE/TYPE OF NEW WINDOWS ON ALL LEVELS OF THE HOME. A plan review is required for enlarging, reducing, or creating new door or window openings (Construction drawings must be submitted for review).

INSPECTIONS ARE REQUIRED. Please call the inspection line at (208) 769-2391 to schedule inspections.

- Doors and windows shall be installed in compliance with the 2018 International Residential Code (IRC).
- Tempered glazing shall be installed in hazardous locations as outlined in IRC section R308.
- New windows installed in rooms utilized as bedrooms and occupied basements shall comply with egress requirements of IRC section R310. Same size window replacement is allowed for existing egress openings, conforming to the building code adopted at the time of construction.
- Door and window insulation values must meet a U-value of .32 or lower. Window label containing U-value must be provided for inspection.
- Window fall protection is required where a window opening is less than 24" above finished floor and greater than 72" above finished grade.
