Solving for Congestion

The I-90, US-95 Interchange is expected to experience double the traffic volume in the next 20 years. Without improvements, traffic will back-up past the interchange ramps and onto I-90 mainline, resulting in high-speed rear end collisions.

Congestion Priorities

1. Reduce back-ups on the US-95 Interchange ramps
2. Improve US-95 operations to efficiently move traffic away from the interchange
3. Address local road operations at US-95 intersections within the interchange's area of influence



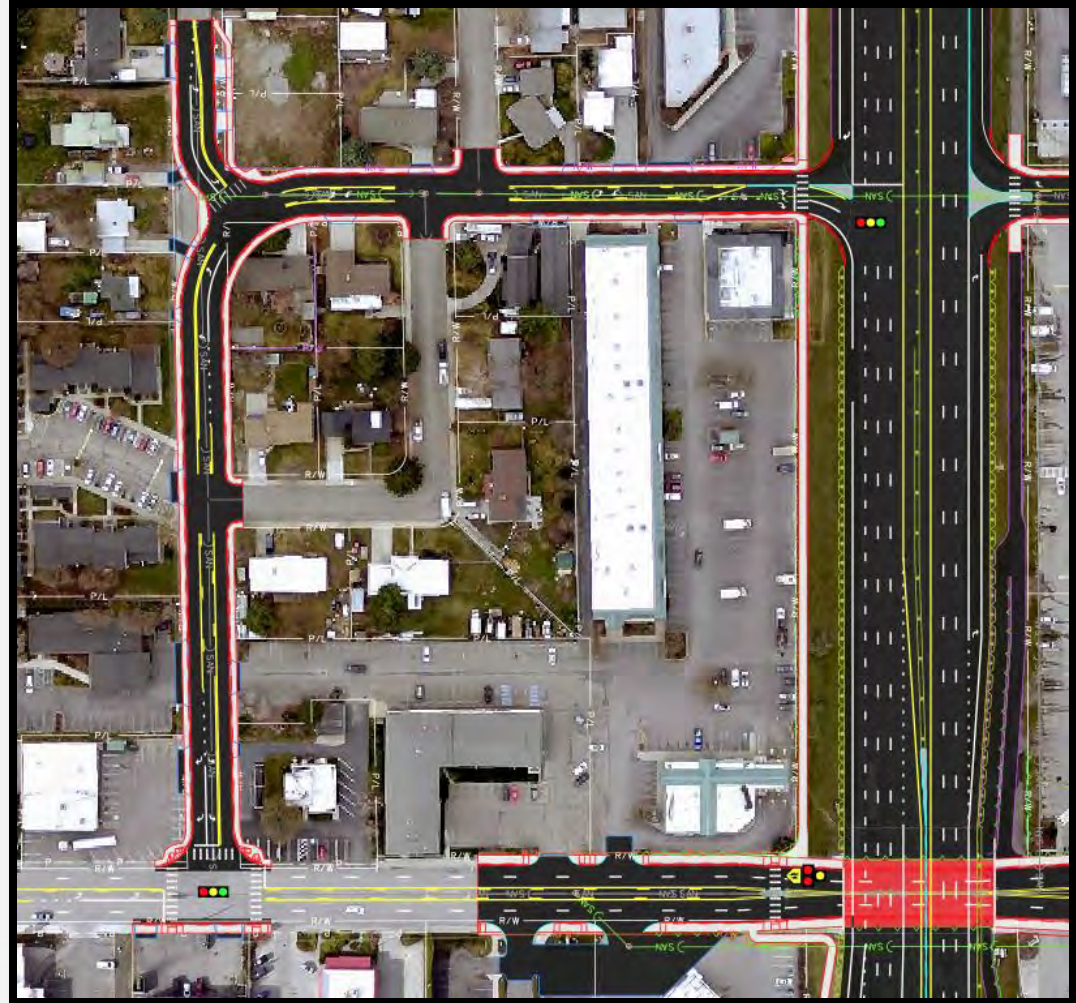
Project Progress and Status Update

- At the March 5 open house, we heard concerns about access to Appleway Ave. from US-95 with the proposed grade separation
- The project team revised the proposed design to include new access routes between Appleway Ave. and US-95
- ITD plans to present the revised proposed design at an open house on November 18

Revised Appleway Access - West

Between Appleway Ave. and US-95

- Connects Appleway Ave. to southbound US-95
- Upgrades Fruitland Ln. and Haycraft Ave. to facilitate this new movement
- A partial southbound signal at US-95 and Haycraft Ave. to facilitate movements onto the highway during heavy traffic conditions
- A new full signal at Fruitland Ln. and Appleway Ave.
- Wayfinding signage will be placed along US-95 and Appleway Ave. to communicate destination directions

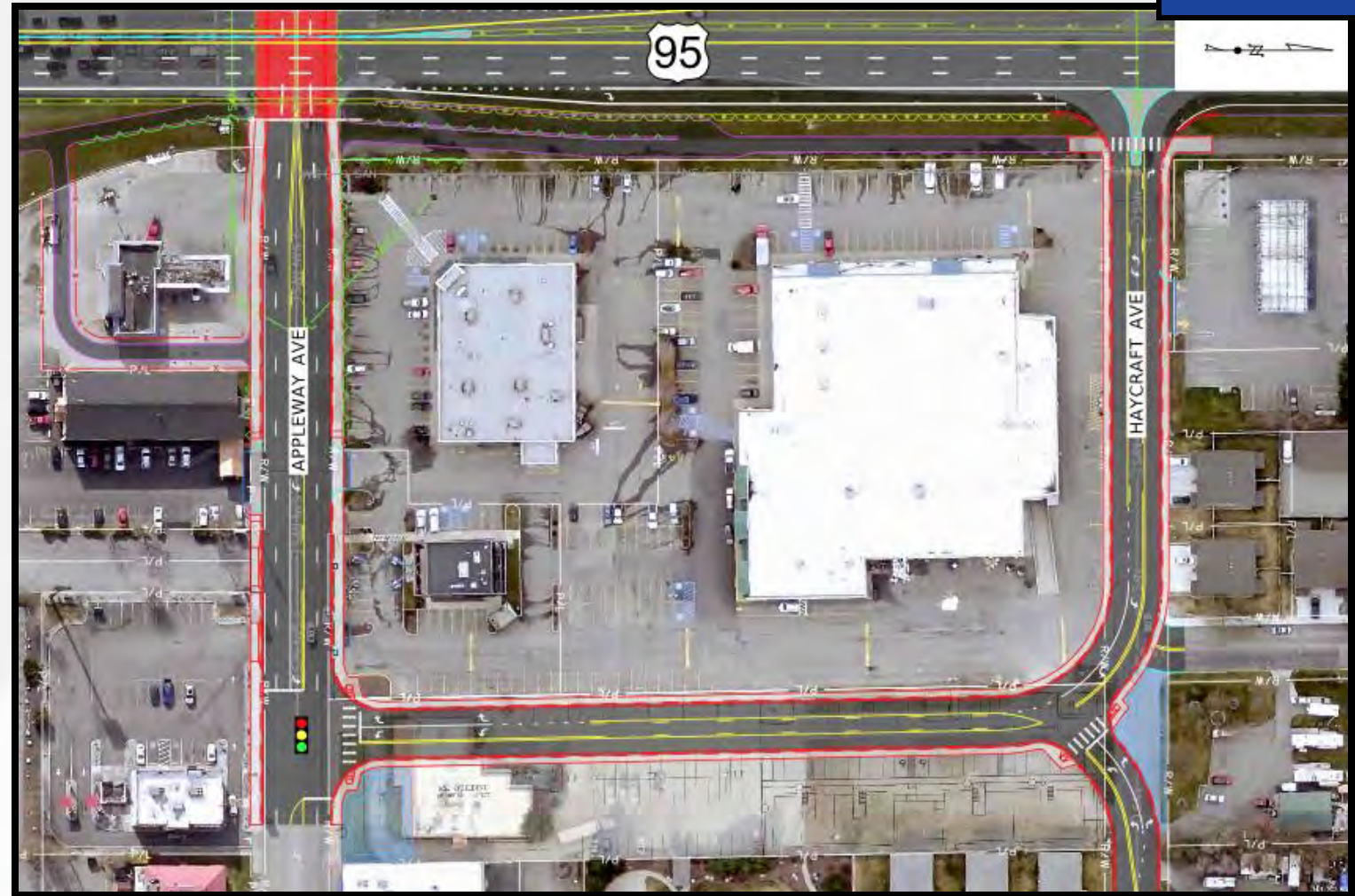


Revised Appleway Access - East

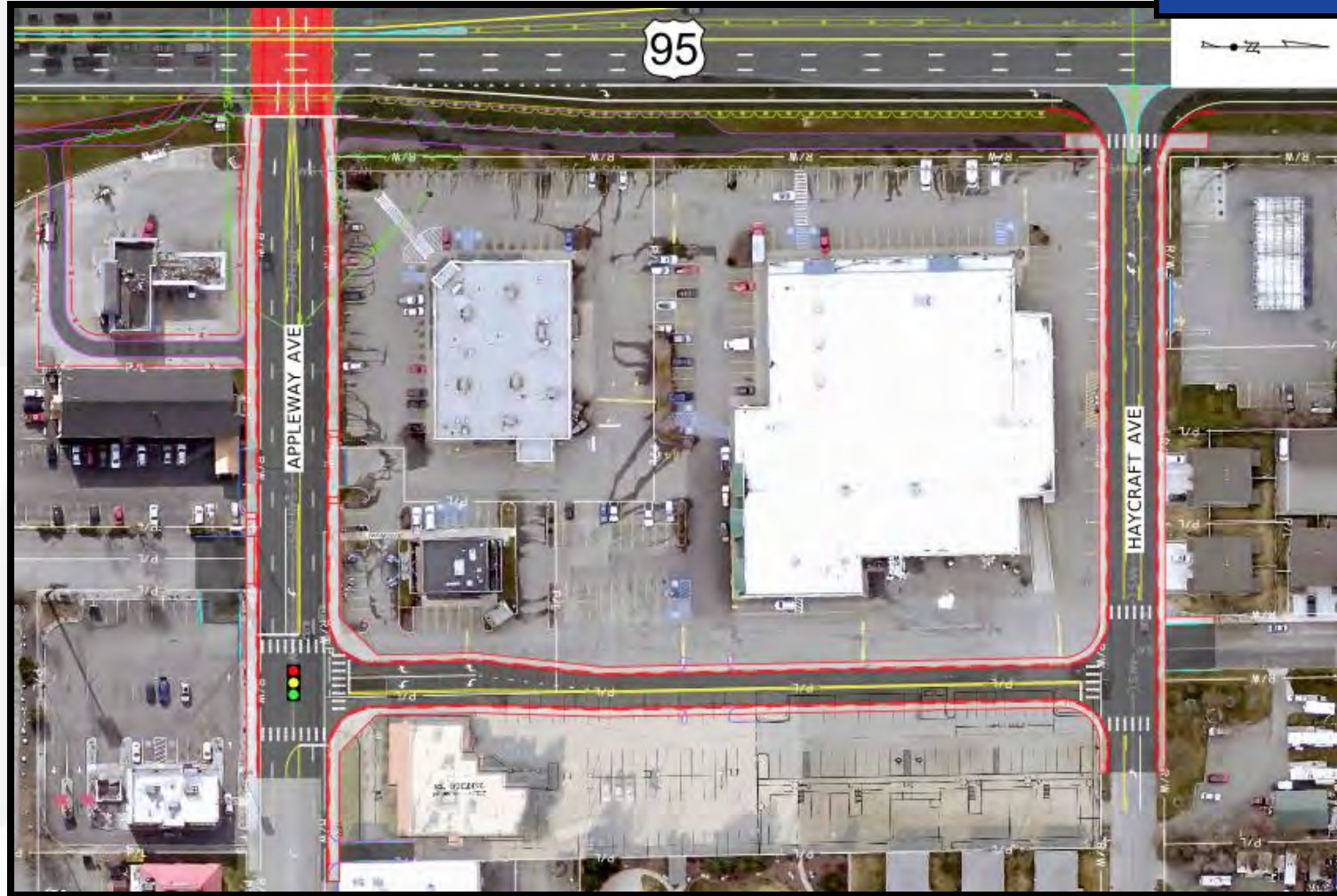

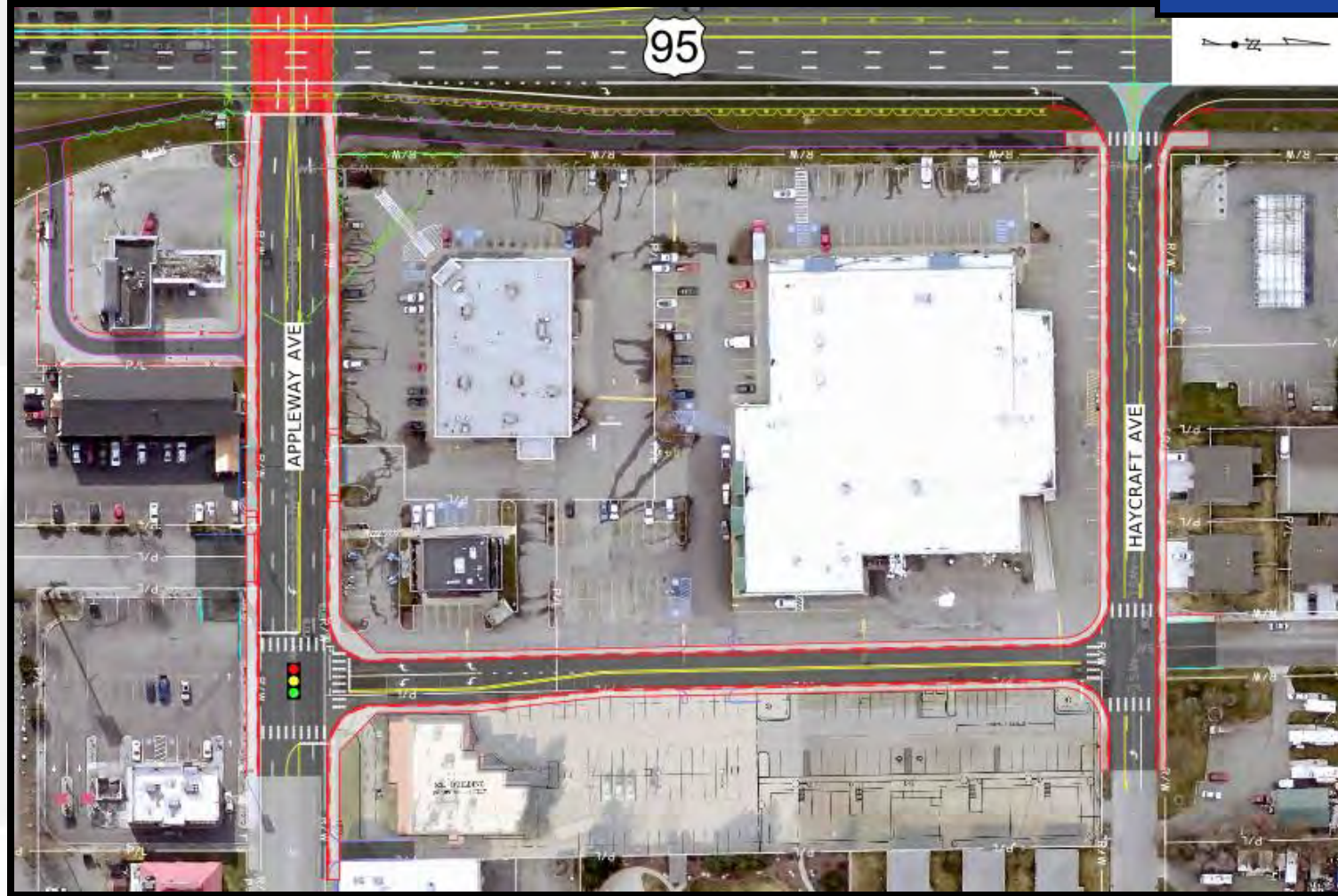

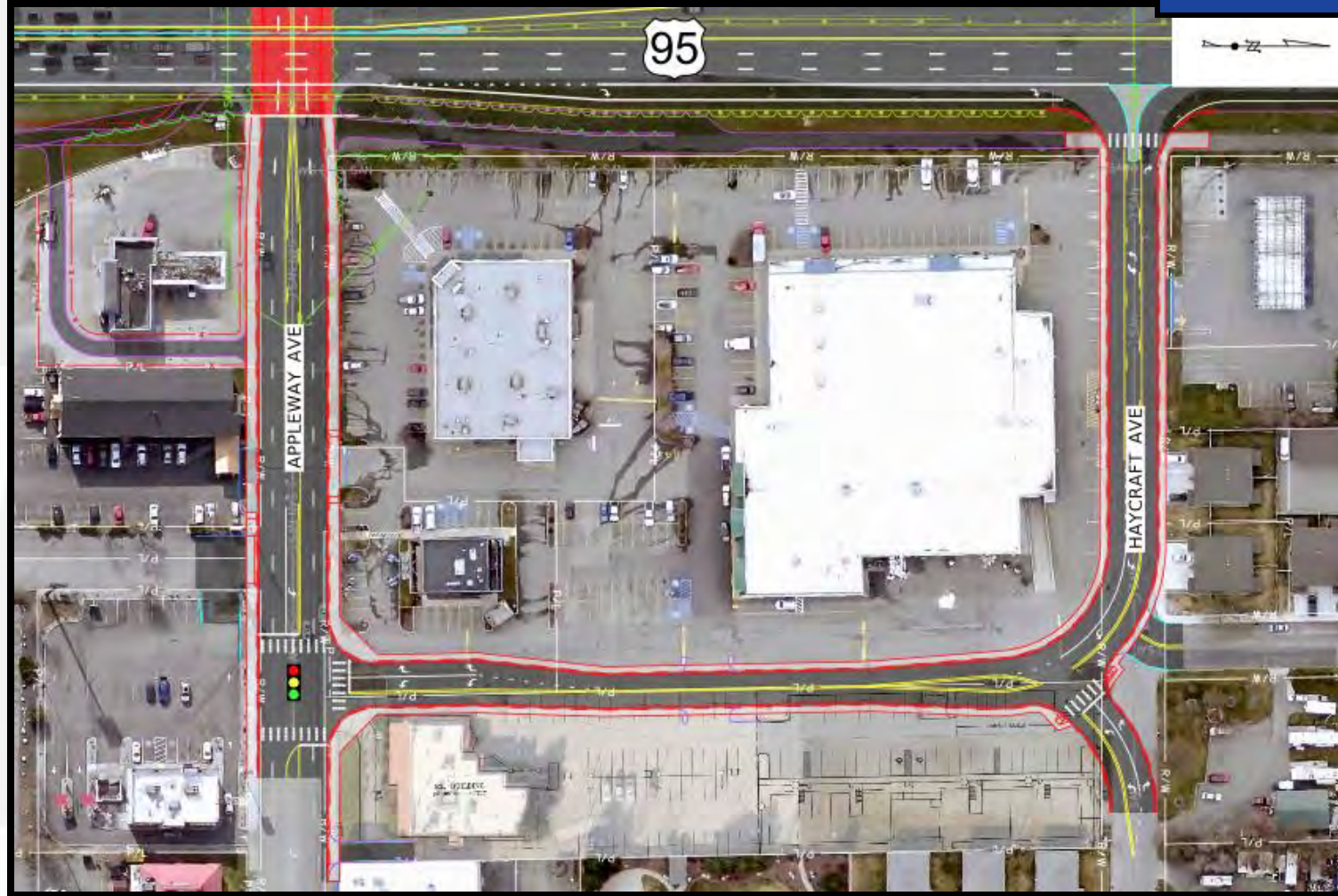
