8,841 Training Hours

- Chief Gabriel was honored with the Lifetime Achievement Award by the Idaho Fire Chiefs Association. This award is given only to those fire chiefs who have made a great impact on the fire service in Idaho and served the association in many roles. The honor has only been given once before over the last 50+ years.
- Firefighter-Paramedic Cody Moore is the newest member of the Kootenai County Joint Agency SWAT Team. Our department now provides three CDAFD firefighter paramedics to the Team.
- CDA firefighters, joined by multiple North Idaho firefighters, made their way up Canfield Mountain in lieu of the LLS Firefighter Stair Climb Fundraiser that was postponed at the Columbia Center in Seattle due to Coronavirus worries. The team raised \$3,298 to support the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society and their fight against blood cancers.
- Deputy Chief Bill Deruyter helped raise \$750 at the Annual Fitness Charity Bike Fundraiser for the Kootenai County Police & Fire Memorial Foundation.
- K9 Scout (and trainer F/F Chad Matchell) and K9 Murphy (and trainer F/F Cody Moore) from our Idaho Disaster Dogs team completed and passed the Canine FSA Test in Seattle. This test covers aspects of obedience, agility and searching. The dogs and their trainers did well and were a great representation of Coeur d'Alene.
- We delivered a brand-new AED (Automated External Defibrillator) device and trainer to the Lake City Senior Center. Funding for this new lifesaving device came from a City Council approved appropriation of CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) funds.
- We teamed up with the Area Agency on Aging of North Idaho, along with help from the Panhandle Health District, to begin an in-home COVID-19 vaccination program. This service is available to any homebound citizens and their direct care providers in all of the Panhandle Health District.
- Local 710 raised 7,500 pounds of food and \$2,734 from Mobile Santa in December for the local food bank. We are thankful to our community for their generosity and support!
