ON MAY 19, 2015, Coeur d'Alene voters will be asked to consider a \$6 million, 10-year public safety bond to fund capital expenditures for the Police and Fire Departments.

THIS IS NOT A NEW TAX. The bond renews a 10-year general obligation bond approved by voters in 2005. The expiring bond upgraded facilities and paid off debt. All projects were completed on time and on budget. **If approved,**

IT WILL REDUCE THE PUBLIC SAFETY PORTION OF THE TAX LEVY RATE BY 18%.
