The City of Coeur d'Alene hereby gives **Notice of Available Funding (NOFA)** and invites competitive grant proposals for projects or services that benefit low-to-moderate income people or neighborhoods, and/or promote job creation/economic development. Any individuals, profit or nonprofit organizations, business, or governmental agencies may apply for City of Coeur d'Alene Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds. Applications may be submitted for one plan year period (Plan Year 2017) for independent programs/projects.

Funding for the City's CDBG Entitlement Program is provided through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), (reference 24 CFR Part 570). Applicants must comply with all applicable federal, state, local laws and regulations.
