- The maximum speed limit is 10 miles per hour.
- Any persons disturbing the peaceful nature of the cemetery will be asked to leave.

# **Cemetery History**

Coeur d'Alene Forest Cemetery is rich in history. People like to stroll through the cemetery to observe the many different styles of monuments and the inscriptions upon the monuments. For example, descendents of Betsy Ross erected a monument in her honor and many Civil War Veterans from the Grand Army of the Republic are buried here.

The soldiers of the local army post, known as "Fort Sherman" abandoned their post and moved to Spokane in the late 1800s. In the early 1900s, the Coeur d'Alene citizenry petitioned President Theodore Roosevelt to convey the old army post cemetery to Coeur d'Alene for a municipal cemetery. In 1905, by proclamation, President Roosevelt gifted the City of Coeur d'Alene with what is now known as "Forest Cemetery."

In the late 1960s, the city purchased additional acreage adjacent to Forest Cemetery and named the new section "Riverview Cemetery." Riverview carries on with the tradition of Forest Cemetery and is complimented by a beautiful cremain Niche Garden area and a veterans section dedicated to all the veterans of the various branches of the U.S. Military.

The gentle terrain of both Forest and Riverview Cemeteries create a peaceful and aesthetic atmosphere. The grounds are well cared for which adds to the serenity of the cemetery. Come and visit, we would love to show you around, or just come by and stroll through at your leisure.
