

CENTENNIAL TRAIL PERMIT

RULES & REGULATIONS

ALL ORGANIZED EVENTS REQUIRE A PERMIT.

- 1) Keep to the right of trail.
- 2) Alcoholic beverages and glass containers are prohibited.
- 3) Pedestrians have right-of-way.
- 4) All users remain on designated trails.
- 5) Bicycle speed limit: 15 mph
- 6) Maximum of two bicycle riders abreast at any time. If pedestrians are present, only single-file riding is allowed.
- 7) Dogs must be on a leash.
- 8) Do not disturb plants or animals.
- 9) Pack-it-in / pack-it-out.
- 10) No structures, including vending equipment, are allowed.
- 11) No motorized vehicles are allowed on the trail.
- 12) Camping is prohibited.
- 13) No chalk or paint allowed. Colored tape is acceptable as long as it is removed within 24 hours.
- 14) All signs must be taken down, trash and “Goo” packets picked up, and markings cleaned off the trail within 24 hours. If this is not done, costs to remove the signs and/or clean the trail will be deducted from the \$500 deposit. If costs exceed the deposit, applicant will be charged for the additional expense.
