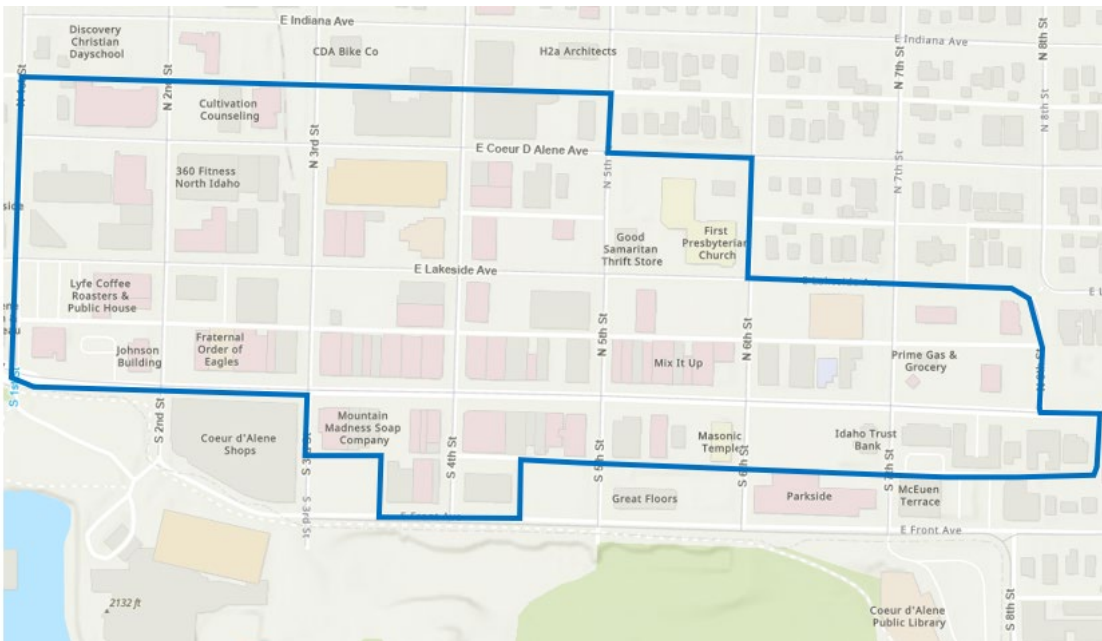

***What is a Reconnaissance Survey?*** *It is a survey of the built environment to assess the overall characteristics of the area, identify the age, architectural styles and building features of structures, historic objects, potential historic properties, and can inform future discussions about possible historic districts. It does not designate properties as historic or affect property rights.*

The survey was funded by a Certified Local Government (CLG) grant. The consultant conducted field work in 2025 and has prepared a Historic Context and Survey Report. The findings and recommendations will be presented at the public meeting. The survey area is shown below.
