



STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTIONS

ONLY YOU CAN PREVENT WILDFIRES.

PROHIBITED:



Building or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire (except within designated sites, or on your own land in appropriate fire structure.)



No smoking in an open area unless cleared of all flammable material within a 3-foot diameter.

PERMITTED:



Fires within an owner-provided structure, defined as permanent metal or concrete improvements designed specifically for the purpose of containing fire.



Using a fire or stove solely fueled by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels.



Smoking within an enclosed vehicle, trailer, building, or area cleared of flammable material.

**All permitted activities must be conducted in an area cleared of all flammable material.*
